Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Berkshire Imaging is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

A large proportion of the activity carried out by Berkshire Imaging is carried out under the umbrella of other public and private sector healthcare organisations who provide their own carbon reduction plans. As such this reports focuses on the Berkshire Imaging office carbon footprint.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Baseline Year: 2026

Additional details relating to the baseline emissions calculations

This was the first Carbon Reduction Plan published by the company and is therefore used as the baseline report for calculated carbon footprint.

Notes

- Scope 3 reductions are driven by reduced travel and hybrid working practices as well as a shift towards virtual / cloud based meetings.

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue to progress towards achieving Net Zero, the following carbon reduction targets have been adopted.

Berkshire Imaging projects that carbon emissions would decrease over the next five years to 8 MTCO2e by 2026. This is a reduction of 21%.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Additional Carbon Reduction Initiatives Implemented

The following additional measures have been implemented since the last reporting period:

- **Hybrid working models:** Reduction in physical infrastructure and paper usage.
- **Travel and Commuting Controls:** Reinforcement of remote collaboration practices to minimise business travel and associated emissions.

Summary Update

In the future, further measures may include:

- Continued effort to source all electricity consumed only from renewable energy providers.
- Reducing travel to a minimum, with cloud-first and web-first approaches to software used and meetings conducted with suppliers and clients.

Forward-Looking Commitments

To maintain momentum towards Net Zero, Berkshire Imaging LLP will:

- Expand Scope 3 emissions tracking with particular focus on diesel and electric cars used for commuting to the Berkshire Imaging office.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
